

**Scenario 1- Donna**

Donna is an 82-year-old woman living in a private residence with her 21-year-old grandson and her grandson's girlfriend. Donna is facing eviction due to non-payment of the mortgage on her residence. Donna's son's girlfriend frequently belittles her, calling her worthless and refusing to speak to her for weeks at a time. Her grandson refuses to let Donna write out checks and instead tells her he will take the money she gives him and pay the bill. He has been keeping the mortgage money instead of paying the bill like Donna believed. A neighbor comes over for a visit and sees the eviction notice in the trash.

**Scenario 2- Kevin**

Kevin is a 76 year old man. Kevin had a stroke 2 months ago and now lives with his daughter and her family. Kevin goes to his doctor for a checkup and the doctor notices food stains and a urine smell on his clothing. Kevin has lost significant weight and reports that he has been having trouble sleeping.

*Would you report this? Why/Why not?*

**Scenario 3- Sarah**

Sarah has been living in an assisted living facility for the past three years, she has a chronic pain disorder and is jokingly called the “difficult patient” by staff because of her frequent late night calls to the nurse. The nurse will sometimes double Sarah’s medication dose to put her to sleep. Sarah’s daughter comes to visit. She notices that her mother’s hair appears to be unwashed and there are burn marks on her mother’s back, she also notices that Sarah’s walker is not within reach of her bed.

*Would you report this? Why/Why not?*
